Dear Mr. Clausen:

This letter is in response to your request for approval of a Nonresident Temporary Importation Exemption for a nonconforming motor vehicle which you own. Based on the information you have provided to us, EPA approves this exemption request. Accordingly, you may import the vehicle identified below for a period up to one year from the date the applicant accepts the terms of the Memorandum of Exemption or the date of importation, whichever is later, per the provisions of code O on EPA Declaration Form 3520-1.

Vehicle Exempted: 2006 Harley Davidson Motorcycle
VIN: 5HD1GX1106K330337

When importing this vehicle, you must attach a copy of this letter and a copy of the Memorandum of Exemption to EPA form 3520-1 provided to U.S. Customs and Border Protection (Customs), and you will need to keep the original for your records. The vehicle may not be sold or otherwise transferred to another party in the United States; the vehicle must be for personal use and cannot be used for commercial purposes, or for principle use by persons other than the importer.

The vehicle must be exported after one year, or upon the nonresident departing the U.S., whichever comes first. This letter does not release the importer from the obligation to comply with Federal motor vehicle safety requirements, applicable gas guzzler taxes, State or local emission requirements, nor does any other letter issued by EPA exempt an importer from these requirements. EPA requires that you send us documentation that the vehicle has been exported along with a copy of this letter.
